

NAMIBIAN JUNIOR CONVENTION GUIDELINES

2011

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

WHO MAY ENTER

The purpose of the Namibian Junior Student Convention is to give Namibian children, between the ages of 10 and 12 years of age, an opportunity to compete and gain convention experience at junior level.

It has been decided to allow students between the ages of 13 and 15 years old to attend and be judged as seniors on all senior convention items during the Namibian Junior Student Convention. This will also serve as a preparation for the All Africa Student Convention in South Africa.

It is **COMPULSORY** for every student to enter one Junior Namibian Convention, one Senior Namibian Convention in Namibia. However, in order to obtain a Graduation Certificate a student must attend either one Namibian Senior Convention and one All Africa Student Convention **or** two All Africa Student conventions.

CALCULATION OF AGE

A child's age is calculated as being in the particular age group by the age he is on the last day of that convention year, i.e. should the child turn 10 any date from 1 January 2020 – 31 December 2020 that child may enter the Namibian Junior Convention of 2020, being calculated as a 10 year old, even though during convention the child may still only be 9 years old.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

1. Schools should have a Student Convention Motivation Meeting, stressing the importance and excitement of convention and leadership training. Parents are then motivated to encourage their children to partake and make it clear to the parents what part the school will play in preparing the student and what will be expected of the parent. (Present a convention video)
2. Make copies of the standard Namibian Convention Notice labelled **PARENT CONVENTION NOTICE**, that is sent out from the convention office, and distribute them to the parents together with the official **NAM CF2 (J/S) NAMIBIAN CONVENTION INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION FORM (JUNIOR or SENIOR)** for each child. (Have a due date for the return of these forms well in advance of the due date for registration of the school for convention.)
3. Transfer the information to the **NAM CF1 – NAMIBIAN GROUP REGISTRATION FORM**, and follow the instructions as indicated on the form or use the **NAMIBIAN COMPUTER REGISTRATION PROGRAMME** when available.

GENERAL

The following is a list of **ALL** the items available for contestants entering the **Namibian Junior Convention** as juniors. Please note that some of the senior convention items

have been **left out** and are not applicable to the junior convention. Some items are without any changes as per the manual, while others have been changed to suit the need of a junior entry as a steppingstone in preparation for the senior All Africa Student Convention.

The (p....) written behind a convention item name, refers to the page number in the All African Student Convention guidelines manual and (RSA convention item) refers to items available in South Africa and not the International Student Convention. There are also items NOT offered during the AASC but they are ISC items and are offered in Namibia, they are identified as (NOT a RSA item). Please note; All **Namibian only** entries are ONLY applicable in Namibia and cannot be used for the All African Student Convention in South Africa or Internationally.

- Items **do not need to be framed but must be mounted within the size limitations** as set out in the manual.

JUNIOR 3D ART: CLAY SCULPTURE, WOOD CONSTRUCTION AND WOODCARVING. (p III 1-2, 4-8)

V. NEEDLE/THREAD

<i>Needlecraft</i>

JUNIOR COUNTED CROSS-STITCH, EMBROIDERY, CROCHET, KNITTING AND QUILTS. (p V 1,4-6)

Follow the guideline as per the manual with the only exception being:

- The items completed require **+/- 100 hours of needlework** done instead of the 200 hours for senior convention.

JUNIOR 80m, 100m, 200m, 400m DASH, 800m, 1200m RUN AND 400m RELAY. (p VI 1-4)

<i>Field Events</i>

JUNIOR HIGH JUMP (p VI 1-4)

No changes follow the manual.

JUNIOR RUNNING LONG JUMP (p VI 1-5)

No changes follow the manual.

JUNIOR SHOT-PUT (p VI 1-3, 5)

Follow the guideline as per the manual with the only exception being:

- This item is only available for those that are **11 years old and older.**

JUNIOR DISCUS (p VI 1-3, 5)

Follow the guideline as per the manual with the only exception being:

- This item is only available for those that are **11 years old and older.**

JUNIOR SOCCER KICK. (p VI 1-3, 5-6)

No changes follow the manual.

JUNIOR PHYSICAL FITNESS. (p VI 1-3, 6-7)

Follow the guideline as per the manual with the only exception being:

- **Pull-ups** must be completed in **02:30 min.**

- **Push-ups** must be completed in **02:30 min.**
- **Sit-ups** must be completed in **05:00 min.**

JUNIOR SOCCER (SIX-A-SIDE). (RSA convention event)

JUNIOR TABLE TENNIS (SINGLES). (p VI 1, 8-9)

JUNIOR VOLLEYBALL. (Namibia & RSA only) (P VI 1, 10-12)
USA female event only but in RSA & Namibia males also

JUNIOR DROPKICK. (Namibia only)

- Full sized rugby posts are required for this item.
- As with soccer kick 5m intervals are marked out on the field starting at the try line under the posts.
- Three attempts are allowed at each distance.
- The rugby ball must clear the cross bar between the two uprights.
- The ball must be purposely released from the hands and fall to the floor point first.
- As the ball falls, the contestant is swinging the leg forwards for the kick and connects with the ball as the ball touches the floor. Neither sooner nor later.
- The contestant may take 3 approach steps before kicking ensuring that he does not cross the mark made for that distance attempt.
- Failure to kick the ball over the cross bar after three attempts eliminates the contestant from further competition.
- The contestant who is able to clear the cross bar the furthest from the posts is the winner of the event.
- A tie is resolved by giving the first place to the contestant who cleared the cross bar in the least number of attempts (e.g. first attempt as opposed to the third attempts for the other contestant) provided that they both failed to clear the cross bar at the next 5m increment.
- If the same number of attempts was used to clear the cross bar then a distance less than 5m is chosen to extend the distance until a winner is found.

JUNIOR NETBALL SHOOT. (Namibia only)

- Ten possible points can be scored from ten successful shoots at the hoop from different places within the circle.
- Students may take 5 practice shots to get their eye in.

Positions:

- 1m from hoop
- 2 X 2m from hoop (1 at right angles to court)
- 3 X 3m from hoop (1 directly in front and 2 on either side of hoop.
- 3 X 4m from hoop (1 directly in front and 2 on either side of hoop.
- 1 X 5m from hoop (directly in front of hoop)

In case of a tie the contestants should compete against each other only by repeating the sequence again.

VII. USA COLOUR GUARD/FLAG CORPS

JUNIOR COLOUR GUARD (MALE). (NOT a RSA event) see additional manual pages from USA (p VII 1-2)

Exception: Junior boys may not use real rifles. Use plastic “bibi” gun rifle, without “bullets”. Further, no changes follow the manual.

JUNIOR DRAMA/MIME. (RSA convention event) (pVIII 1-3, 23-24)

No changes; see RSA guidelines and Judges forms.

Cultural

JUNIOR SPEECH-CHOIR. (Namibia only)

This is a Namibian event only, with the following criteria:

- The choir can be male and female mixed.
- There may be a minimum of 4 and NO maximum number of contestants.

- Any Namibian's home language may be used, provided the following point is adhered to.
- The school that enters this event must provide a Judge that speaks the language used in the piece being presented if it is a language other than English.
- The piece presented must display a moral or Biblical value, and a translation into English must be read to the audience.
- Formal platform dress code is applicable, according to the International Student Convention guidelines.
- The time limit is 4 – 6 minutes.
- Remember it is not a singing choir, however, a short 2 – 3 line phrase may be sung to express a point.
- It is also not a One-Act Play; therefore, the minimum number of people speaking at one time is 4.
- Use Judges form NCF

POETRY RECITATION (Namibia only)

This is a Namibian event only, with the following criteria:

- It may be done in any other Namibian Language other than English.
- The school that enters this event must provide a Judge that speaks the language used in the piece being presented.
- The piece presented must display a moral or Biblical value, and a translation into English must be read to the audience.
- Formal platform dress code is applicable, according to the International Student Convention guidelines.
- The Judging will be as for normal English Poetry Recitation. CF84

VIII. DANCE

JUNIOR CREATIVE PRAISE & WORSHIP DANCE AND ISRAELI DANCE.

(RSA convention event) (p VIII 1-3, 25-28)

No changes; see RSA guidelines and Judges forms.

JUNIOR GUMBOOT DANCE. (Namibia only)

Criteria

- This is designed to be a fast active boot dance.
- It must be Christian
- Time limit 5 minutes
- There may be no sensual or provocative movements. Each movement must have definite purpose.
- The purpose of this item is to provide an energetic fun dance for the youth.
